## NFPA 1126 Study Guide - Chapter 1

### General

This section is a brief outline, defining the overall provisions of the NFPA 1123 and the areas that it applies to.

#### **Section 1-2: Purpose:**

The purpose of this standard shall be to provide:

- Requirements for the use of Pyrotechnics indoor or outdoor for the reasonable protection of:
  - ~ \*Pyrotechnic operators
  - ~ Performers
  - ~ Property
  - ~ Support Personnel
  - ~ Viewing Proximate Audiences
  - ~ Buildings
- Guidelines to the *\*Authority having jurisdiction* for the approval of the use of Pyrotechnics as specified in 1-2.1
- Requirements for local permits

#### **Section 1-3: Equivalency:**

~This standard is *not* intended to prevent the use of systems, methods or devices that provide **protection** equivalent to the provisions of this standard, (*See sec. 6-1-5*)

- Provided such equivalency can be demonstrated to the \*authority having jurisdiction.

( I.E....You can use other measures for protection that may not necessarily be in this guide, as long as you can demonstrate to the \*AHJ that your measures are adequate.)
